

## **5- Day Sossusvlei and Swakopmund - Price available on request**

### **Day 1: Windhoek to Kulala Desert Lodge**



We start our journey with a flight south-west to the sand sea, one of the most scenic landscapes in Namibia. We also pass over part of the Naukluft Mountains the Khomas Hochland range on our journey.

We cross over the grassland savannah and farmland areas before the terrain begins to give way to the immense red sand dune desert of the Namib. Once we get to our lodge, the gateway to world's largest dunes of Sossusvlei, we will head to the closest dune to get a little taste of what to expect the next day, and to catch a beautiful sunset

### **Day 2: Kulala Desert Lodge**



A pre-dawn start is optional this morning if we want to catch the soft light of the sunrise from the top of Dune 45. Once all the perfect photos have been captured, we will enjoy a breakfast amongst these terrific dunes, famed for both their size and age.

We reach our final destination Sossusvlei itself 5 km (3.1miles) from our parking area, by means of a shuttle service through the dunes. The breath-taking views of the different dune formations and enjoying the changing light, coolness of the morning, and viewing the ancient mineral pans, stunted camel thorn trees and the chance of seeing a Gemsbok, Ostrich and Springbok.

We spend the morning in and around Sossusvlei and Deadvlei area, also having the opportunity to climb Big Daddy Dune, arguably the largest sand dune in the world.

As the desert warms up, we will head back to Sesriem for a delicious lunch, and some much needed time around the swimming pool. As the day cools off in the late afternoon we will take a short excursion to the Sesriem Canyon, to catch another beautiful sunset.

### **Day 3: Sossusvlei to Okahirongo Elephant Lodge**



We depart for the Skeleton coast today.

Along the way to our lodge we will take a 30 minute flight over the skeleton coast protected area. Upon arrival at our lodge we will have time to relax for the afternoon at our accommodation and head acquaint ourselves with the local cuisines on offer

### **Day 4: Okahirongo Elephant Lodge**



The day will consist of scheduled activities that include game drives as well as tracking of the unique desert elephants, lions, cultural visits and much more. The day can conclude with a delicious dinner after a beautiful Ocean sunset
